About Ozu Town

大津町の紹介

Ozu town has a population of about 30,000 people and is located on Kyushu, Japan's southernmost main island. Ozu is in the Northern part of Kumamoto prefecture, about 20 kilometers (12.5 miles) to the east of Kumamoto City. It is found between Kumamoto City and Mt. Aso.

Route 57 and the JR Hohi Train Line (Hohi-honsen), two of central Kyushu's major transportation routes, cross the city from east to west and provide easy access to all parts of Kyushu. Kumamoto Airport is also located in the local vicinity. The various means of transportation have helped make Ozu a prosperous and industrialized town.

Currently several international and domestic enterprises are located in Ozu and through these companies Ozu has become very well known. The most predominate point of Ozu's industrial strength is the Honda Motor Company.

On the other hand, away from the urban area you can also see beautiful scenery and abundant nature such as rice fields, bountiful forests and the gigantic caldera of Mt. Aso. Ozu's location near Mt. Aso, an active volcano, is the origin of its unique agriculture which allows the town to specialize in cultivating sweet potatoes (karaimo) to a quality level that has become famous throughout Japan.

The convenient transportation, modern atmosphere, and the incredible natural scenery make Ozu a wonderful place to live!
